Inventory Guide

Track MTG singles, sealed products and accessories with Scryfall-powered metadata, stock controls, search, filters and listing overrides.

Use this when adding or cleaning stock.

Applies to Toploader OS v1.4.7. Use this guide as workflow support, not as financial, legal, tax or marketplace policy advice.

Choose the right item type

Inventory supports more than single cards. Singles use the Scryfall card search flow, while sealed products and accessories use cost plus target-margin pricing.

- **Single Card** - Use for exact MTG printings and finishes.
- **Booster Pack or Sealed Box** - Use for sealed product pricing and pack-level values.
- **Accessories and lots** - Use for sleeves, deck boxes, playmats, graded cards, bundles and other product lines.

Add a single card with Scryfall search

- 1 Choose Single Card.
- 2 Type at least part of the card name and select a Scryfall suggestion.
- 3 Open variants and choose the exact set, collector number and finish.
- 4 Confirm the preview, market price, public image URL and finish treatment.
- 5 Set quantity and save. If the same exact print already exists, choose whether to merge or create a separate entry.

Exact printing matters. Set code, collector number and finish make exports and analytics more reliable than a simple card-name row.

Add sealed products and accessories

For non-single items, enter cost, target margin and stock quantity. Sealed boxes can also use packs-per-box so the app can calculate both box and pack sale prices.

- Use VAT/tax checkboxes deliberately so the cost is not accidentally inflated twice.
- Save public image URLs for marketplace exports, especially for custom accessories.
- Use Whatnot listing overrides when a product needs a different condition, listing type or shipping profile.

Stock changes without repricing

Use Adjust Stock when you only need to change quantity. This avoids changing cost, margin or saved sale prices. Use Edit/Reprice when you intentionally want to change pricing inputs.

Search, filters and attention checks

- Search by name, set code, collector number, artist, rarity and stored Scryfall metadata.
- Use quick filters for singles, sealed, products, missing images, zero quantity and ready-for-Whatnot status.
- Sort by quantity, price, market value, stock value, estimated payout or attention issues.
- Use Card Analytics to understand colour density, set spread and rarity split for singles.

Final checklist

- Single cards have exact printings and finishes.

- Marketplace-ready items have public image URLs.
- Zero-quantity items are intentional.
- Stock changes use Adjust Stock when no pricing change is intended.

Keep this guide near the app while you build muscle memory. The best workflow is usually inventory first, show or export second, reconciliation third, analytics last.
