Live Tools Guide

Use the Live Break Recorder, Live Set Balancer and Singles Checker during streams and buyer conversations.

Use this while live or preparing buyer service tasks.

Applies to Toploader OS v1.4.7. Use this guide as workflow support, not as financial, legal, tax or marketplace policy advice.

Live Break Recorder

Use the recorder to log finalized randomizer assignments from Whatnot. The app supports preset break types such as colour breaks and digi breaks, and can export a pull sheet for operational use.

- Select the break type.
- Enter names or assignments in the generated slots.
- Export the pull sheet before sorting or packing.
- Clear names when you start a new break.

Live Set Balancer

The balancer tracks auction sales against a target and recalculates the minimum slot price for remaining slots. Use it when early auctions over- or under-perform and you need to keep the live event profitable.

- 1 Enter total set slots and base target price per slot.
- 2 Start tracking.
- 3 Log each sale price as it happens.
- 4 Watch slots sold, net collected and new minimum slot price.

Singles Checker

Paste a buyer want list and check single-card inventory across profiles. This is useful for helping buyers during live streams or preparing private offers.

- Paste one card per line, including quantities such as 2x Rhystic Study.
- Check Singles to compare requested cards against inventory.
- Review matched single, variant, inventory profile and price.
- Export results when you need a record or buyer follow-up list.

Live-use tips

- Keep the app on a second monitor when possible.
- Avoid major imports while live.
- Use backups before a large show day.
- Export live sheets before sorting physical items.

Final checklist

- Break assignments are recorded.
- Balancer totals are updated after each sale.
- Buyer want lists have been checked across the right inventory profiles.
- Exported live sheets are saved before fulfilment.

Keep this guide near the app while you build muscle memory. The best workflow is usually inventory first, show or export second, reconciliation third, analytics last.
