Settings and Licensing Guide

Configure fees, export defaults, app preferences, backups, inventory profiles, privacy settings and the Toploader OS Pro licence.

Use this when setting up or maintaining the app.

Applies to Toploader OS v1.4.7. Use this guide as workflow support, not as financial, legal, tax or marketplace policy advice.

Fee, region and rounding settings

Settings control commission, processing percentage, flat fee, VAT/tax percentage, region and single-card rounding. These choices affect pricing, payout estimates and currency display.

Export defaults and templates

Configure marketplace categories, subcategories, listing types, default condition, shipping profile and listing templates. Templates support placeholders such as name, product type, set name, collector number, finish, quantity and sale price.

Good defaults save time. Bad defaults create repeated cleanup in every export.

Toploader OS Pro

The free edition keeps inventory accessible, while Pro unlocks automation such as imports, exports, reconciliation, multiple inventories and bulk workflows. The app uses Lemon Squeezy licensing and stores local licence state.

Backups and restores

- 1 Open Settings.
- 2 Confirm the active inventory profile.
- 3 Choose Backup Active to create a ZIP.
- 4 Store backups somewhere safe before imports or reconciliations.
- 5 Use Restore Into Active only when you intentionally want to overwrite the current active profile.

Privacy and usage analytics

Usage analytics are optional and are designed to send sanitised feature usage events, not card names, buyer lists, inventory contents, CSV contents, file paths, tokens or personal details.

Multiple inventory profiles

Use profiles when you need separate inventories for different stock collections or selling contexts. Each profile keeps its own inventory, sales, shows, export history, snapshots and local images.

Final checklist

- Fee settings match your current assumptions.
- Export templates have been reviewed.
- Pro licence status is known.
- Backups exist before risky changes.
- Analytics consent matches your privacy preference.

Keep this guide near the app while you build muscle memory. The best workflow is usually inventory first, show or export second, reconciliation third, analytics last.
